Your Smile Transformation involves comprehensive planning and careful craftsmanship. While key steps take place in our clinic, much of the work happens behind the scenes in partnering laboratories, where ceramists design and create your restorations using evidence-based techniques.

With intraoral scanning, CAD/CAM systems, and Al-powered tools, we develop a digital preview of your smile before proceeding with treatment. An important step in this process is the Trial Smile, allowing you to experience a temporary version of your new look before confirming the final design.

Our team follows ethical and clinically approved protocols, helping to ensure that all treatments meet health and safety standards for optimal long-term results.

Your Smile Transformation: A Quick Guide

1. Consultation & Data Gathering (Appointment 1 - No Charge)

- Discuss your smile goals and concerns.
- Comprehensive oral health assessment.
- Digital 3D scans, photos, and X-rays taken for analysis.
- A \$600 (+GST) deposit is required to initiate the digital design and Trial Smile preview at Appointment 2. This deposit will be credited back toward your final treatment if you proceed with the approved plan.

Smile Planning (happens between Appointment 1 & 2)

- Digital design of your new smile.
- Assessment of facial harmony and functional needs.
- Selection of partnering lab for custom restorations.
- Creation of a 3D-printed Trial Smile for previewing.

2. Trial Smile & Treatment Plan Presentation (Appointment 2)

- Temporary, 3D-printed version of your new smile is fitted (already paid in advance at Appointment 1).
- Wear for 24 hours to trial the aesthetic.
- Review treatment options, timeline, and costs.
- Choose a payment plan that works for you.

3. Trial Smile Feedback & Final Adjustments (Appointment 3)

- Trial Smile removed, adjustments noted.
- Confirm final treatment plan and schedule next steps.
- Secure appointment slots with a deposit if needed.

4. Smile Crafting & Treatment Process (Appointment 4)

For composite or no-prep porcelain veneers, steps 5 and 6 are often combined — meaning your treatment may be completed in a single sitting.



- Preparatory treatments (aligners, whitening, implants if needed).
- Conservative tooth preparation for veneers/crowns if required.
- Digital scanning and lab fabrication of final restorations for porcelain and prep-based cases.
- Composite veneers may be completed chairside in one visit, depending on your treatment plan.
- Temporary restorations provided while waiting for final fit (where applicable).

5. Final Smile Placement (Appointment 5: 1-2 weeks later)

- Final veneers/crowns placed and bonded securely.
- Adjustments made for optimal fit and function.
- Polishing and final bite alignment.

6. Follow-Up & Aftercare

- 48-hour check-up to ensure comfort and bite alignment.
- Two-week review for stability and adjustments.
- Long-term care: Maintain good oral hygiene and regular dental visits. Note: Composite veneers may require in-clinic polishing from time to time to maintain colour.

Veneer Materials at a Glance

Choosing the right veneer material is an important part of your Smile Transformation. **Each option has unique benefits when it comes to aesthetics, durability, cost, and treatment time.** This guide provides a side-by-side comparison to help you understand the key differences — and to support a confident decision during your planning phase.

Getting the Most Out of Your First Appointment

APPOINTMENT 1

Comprehensive Smile Consultation (No Charge)

Appointment 1 is a one-on-one consultation designed to assess your oral health, understand your smile goals, and gather precise diagnostic data for a tailored treatment plan.

During this appointment, we:

- Discuss your concerns, goals, and expectations in detail to understand what you want to achieve.
- Perform a comprehensive oral health assessment, evaluating your gums, teeth, and overall dental condition.
- Gather diagnostic data:
 - Digital 3D scans for accuracy.
 - High-resolution photos and videos to analyse how your teeth and smile fit your face, your facial anatomy, form and feature.
 - X-rays to assess underlying health of the teeth and bone.





Next Steps

If you choose to proceed with Appointment 2, we will begin designing your digital smile and creating a digitally designed mock version for you to trial. A \$600 (+GST) deposit is required to initiate this process. This deposit is paid at Appointment 1 and will be credited back toward your final treatment if you proceed with the approved plan. Your personalised treatment plan options will also be presented at your next appointment.

Between Appointment 1 & 2: Smile Planning (Part of Step 1)

This phase happens behind the scenes between your first and second appointments. While it's not a separate appointment, it plays an essential role in finalising your smile design as part of Step 1. During this stage, we carefully design your smile using digital tools:

- Detailed Analysis We assess your dental records and digitally map your new smile.
- Facial Harmony Assessment We evaluate how your teeth interact with your lips, face shape, and speech for a natural look.
- Bespoke Lab Selection Based on your needs, we choose the ideal lab to craft your smile.
- Mock-Up Creation Using specialised technology, we produce a temporary version of your new smile for you to trial at your next appointment.



What is a Trial Smile?

Your Trial Smile is a **temporary**, **digitally designed**, **3D-printed version** of your new smile, applied over your current natural teeth using a **temporary material**. This lets you see and experience your new look in real life before committing to permanent restorations. This is a completely temporary process and your teeth will not be affected. You'll wear your Trial Smile for 24 hours, allowing time to adjust to the look, gather feedback from family and friends, and ensure it aligns with your vision.

APPOINTMENT 2

Trial Smile Fitting & Treatment Plan

During this appointment:

- → Your **Trial Smile** is fitted, allowing you to preview the design in real life.
- Your customised treatment plan options are presented, covering aesthetic and functional goals, timeline, budget, and treatment options such as veneers, crowns, implants, or aligners.
- You get to preview and provide instant feedback, ensuring the design aligns with your expectations before approval.



Your Personalised Treatment Plan

Once you're happy with your Trial Smile and ready to move forward, we'll guide you through the next steps and present a personalised range of treatment options tailored to your needs.

- A variety of treatment plans (TPs) Ranging from the most basic approach to the most comprehensive solution, giving you a full understanding of your available choices.
- Step-by-step recommendations We will outline all possible solutions within this range, helping you select the option that best fits your goals, budget, and lifestyle.
- Aesthetic and functional goals Helping to ensure your final smile aligns with both your vision and long-term dental health.
- Treatment timeline A clear breakdown of the phases involved in your treatment.
- Associated costs A transparent overview of pricing for each option.
- Treatment options These may include veneers, crowns, implants, teeth whitening, or orthodontics (aligners), depending on your unique needs.
- Payment plan options A breakdown of available payment structures to help make your transformation more manageable (see table below).

At the next appointment, we will require the following in order to move forward:

- → Your **final feedback** on the Trial Smile.
- Onfirmation of your chosen treatment plan.
- → Your preferred scheduling timeframe.
- Onfirmation on your **chosen payment plan**.




We encourage you to finalise your decisions at your next appointment (Appointment 3); however, we understand that you may need an additional 1-2 weeks to review your options.

If you'd like to secure a treatment slot while finalising your decision, we're happy to **tentatively reserve your preferred dates.** For appointments **exceeding three hours**, a **10% interim deposit** is required to hold time with our clinic, doctor, ceramist, and lab. This deposit is needed to coordinate multiple teams and resources, and it applies regardless of the treatment plan or payment option you choose. Your **tentative appointment will remain valid for 1–2 weeks**, giving you the flexibility to confirm your decision during that time.

Interim Deposit for Extended

Procedures

If you need more time to decide on your **treatment and payment plan**, we still recommend that you **tentatively reserve an appointment** due to limited availability. For appointments exceeding **three hours**, a **10% deposit** is required to secure the **clinic**, **doctor**, **ceramist**, **and lab's time**. This deposit will be **applied to your chosen payment plan** once you finalise your treatment. We recommend making a final decision within **1–2 weeks** to keep your treatment on schedule.



Once your **feedback** is incorporated and everything is finalised, we begin preparing to bring your final smile to life.

APPOINTMENT 4

Treatment Preparation & Restoration Fabrication

Additional Treatments Before Preparation

To optimise the health of your teeth, gums, and bone, as well as enhance the final aesthetics, your approved treatment plan may require certain procedures—such as aligners, teeth whitening, implants, periodontal treatments, fillings, or bondings—to be completed before proceeding with tooth preparation for veneers or crowns. These treatments will be scheduled and completed separately.

Your Comfort is Our Priority

To ensure a **relaxing experience**, we offer a full menu of comfort options including **music**, **movies**, **blankets**, **and sedation**.

Tooth Preparation for Final Restoration

We follow a **conservative approach**, preserving as much natural tooth structure as possible while preparing your teeth for **veneers or crowns**. This preparation is based on the **smile design you approved during the Trial Smile stage**.

Digital Design & 3D Modelling

Using 3D scanning, we create precise digital models of your teeth preparations that guide the fabrication of your final restorations in the lab.

Temporary Restorations

Following tooth preparation, you will wear **temporary restorations** for approximately **1–2 weeks** while your final veneers or crowns are being fabricated in the lab. These temporary restorations:

- Are durable and natural-looking, allowing you to function normally.
- Give you an additional opportunity to evaluate the design before final fabrication.



For **composite** and **no-prep ceramic veneers**, this appointment may look a little different. In these cases, **your veneers are typically created and completed chair-side or are pre-milled based on the approved smile design.** This means the restorations can often be placed in a single visit, without the need for temporary veneers or multiple lab stages.

Porcelain Restorations Fabrication & Customisation Once finalised, your restorations go through the fabrication process:

- Digital Milling Using CAD/CAM technology, we refine the shape, bite alignment, and fit for optimal precision.
- Premium Materials Your veneers or crowns are milled from highquality materials such as Emax porcelain or Zirconia, chosen for their strength, longevity, and natural aesthetics.
- Hand Finishing & Customisation Our master ceramists carefully layer, stain, and polish each restoration to achieve a seamless, natural look that blends with your surrounding teeth.
- Strength Testing & Final Quality Check Each restoration undergoes bite calibration, symmetry assessment, and quality control to ensure long-term durability and comfort.

Shade Discussion Appointment

Usually the final shade is selected at appointment 4 however for some patients, we may recommend an additional shade selection appointment at the lab. This allows our ceramists to ensure the precise colour, translucency, and natural characteristics of your final restorations is achieved.

Once this phase is complete, your **final smile** is **ready for placement!** This is the moment where your custom veneers or crowns are ready to be permanently placed, helping to ensure an accurate fit, function, and natural aesthetic.

Permanent Bonding Once you're completely happy, we use high-strength dental bonding materials

to securely attach your veneers or crowns.

Bite Alignment & Polishing We fine-tune your bite for comfort and polish everything for a smooth,

natural finish.

While your restorations are placed with precision, every bite is unique — and minor adjustments may occasionally be needed. At your follow-up appointments, we'll check that your bite feels comfortable and make any refinements needed to ensure everything functions and fits just right.

If any minor adjustments are needed, we provide ongoing support and refinements to help ensure that your smile feels just right.

hard foods

Attend regular hygiene

recall visits

Who is eligible for a Smile Transformation?

A Smile Transformation is for anyone looking to enhance their smile—whether for aesthetic reasons or to improve function and long-term dental health.

Some patients prefer subtle refinements to enhance their natural smile, while others opt for a dramatic transformation. In some cases, the procedure is necessary to restore function, especially when addressing bite issues, worn teeth, or missing teeth.

Before we begin, a thorough clinical exam is required to ensure your oral health is in good condition for treatment. If any underlying issues need attention first, we'll guide you through the steps to get there.

How much does the Smile Transformation Consultation and Smile Trial cost?

Your Smile Transformation Consultation is FREE OF CHARGE and includes:

- A full clinical exam.
- A discussion about your concerns and smile goals.
- High-quality digital scans, x-rays, and scientific record-taking.

Your Smile Design and Smile Trial will cost \$600 (*gst), which is credited toward your treatment if you proceed and includes:

- A 3D-printed trial of your new smile through a wearable Smile Trial, giving you the opportunity to preview your transformation before any permanent changes are made.
- All possible treatment and payment plan presentations.
- → A follow-up consultation with a specialist if needed.

Are the Smile Transformation Consultation and Smile Trial Painful?

Not at all! At this stage, there is no trimming of your natural teeth, so no injections or anaesthesia are needed. Until you give final approval, all appointments—including consultations and mock trial fittings—are purely for planning and are completely reversible.

You will have digital scans and X-rays taken, which some may find slightly uncomfortable, but we'll do our best to ensure a smooth and comfortable experience.

How much does the full Smile Transformation cost?

Every Smile Transformation is completely tailored to the individual. There's no one-size-fits-all pricing because treatments vary based on personal goals, material used, oral health, and specific needs.

For example:

- Some patients require aligners and implants to replace missing teeth.
- Others may only need veneers and/or whitening for a refined, natural look.

If you have a specific budget in mind, let us know at your consultation—we will design a plan that aligns as closely as possible with your financial comfort.

How long does a Smile Transformation take?

It depends on your case, materials used and the complexity of treatment.

- For straightforward cases (no major changes needed), your new smile can be ready within 2-6 weeks across 2-4 appointments.
- For more advanced cases (such as orthodontics, implants, or multiple treatments), the process may take several months or up to one plus year in complex cases.

We'll provide a clear treatment timeline at your consultation.

What maintenance and commitment are required after treatment?

Caring for your new smile is simple! The key is consistent oral hygiene and regular dental check-ups.

- Brush and floss daily.
- Attend your routine hygiene recall and check-ups—this ensures longevity for veneers, crowns, or other restorations.

What materials are used for veneers and crowns?

We offer several materials for veneers and crowns, each selected based on your smile goals, clinical needs, and lifestyle.

Porcelain (Emax)

Known for its natural translucency and long-lasting durability.

- High strength
- Beautiful, lifelike aesthetics
- Ideal for moderate to complex smile makeovers

Zirconia

Incredibly strong and durable, making it ideal for high-stress areas.

- Excellent strength and longevity
- → Good aesthetics (though slightly less translucent than Emax)
- Often used for crowns or patients who grind their teeth

Composite Resin

A more affordable, minimally invasive option placed directly onto the tooth surface.

- Same-day smile improvements
- → Reversible and conservative

The best material for your treatment will be recommended during your digital design phase, based on your individual needs and preferences.
